Personal Accountability Commitment

- Agree to wear a mask or facial covering, if required by the NAREB.
- Adhere to social distance protocols put in place by the NAREB and respect others' personal space.
- Go to a local health facility at any time, if you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms. A list of facilities will be provided.
